| To provide a choir at lunchtime for KS2 children to work towards the "Christmas Celebration" event at a local venue | SLG to register interest from the children in years 3-6 and contact parents | Children will benefit from taking part in a large scale performance with other schools | Sept 24 SLG has registered with Wema to take part |
| To provide more opportunities for all children to perform to an audience, either singing or playing instruments. This could be as a class or as an individual if lessons are taken outside of school | SLG to register to receive packs of resources for Mini Music Makers, Hear My Voice and Raise the Roof Arrange later in the school year an opportunity for parents and visitors to attend a performance | Children will have a sense of achievement and will develop self confidence, particularly when taking part in a performance. | Sept 24 SLG has registered for these packs |
